Award Information:

The purpose of this research award is to encourage APALA members to engage in research activities with a contribution toward library and information science in general and APA librarianship in particular. The grant may be used for conducting research projects, attending research related conferences and workshops, conducting research workshops and programs, or assisting in research writing. This award may not be used for attending professional association conferences.

Eligibility:

Applicants must possess an MLS degree (or equivalent), and be employed in a professional level position. Applicants must have held an APALA membership one year prior to submitting an application, and must maintain APALA membership for the duration of the Grant. An APALA member who receives any other APALA grant may not receive this Grant award in the same year. This award is open only to American citizens or permanent residents.

Application & Submission:

A completed application consists of a cover letter, resume (included at lease one reference), and a statement of intended research activities (limit to 5 pages). Application materials should be submitted to the APALA Scholarship Committee Chair(s), and must be received via email with "APALA Research Grant" as Subject no later than February 1.
